# National News

Accenture launches learning platform; to acquire edtech Udacity

• Accenture has launched Accenture Learn Vantage, a technology learning and training services for its clients.

- The company will invest \$1 billion in Accenture Learn Vantage over three years and has agreed to acquire educational platform Udacity.
- Accenture Learn Vantage will help clients re-skill and upskill in the areas of technology, data and AI to fill gaps created by advances in technologies.

### First Bharat Steam Boiler Expo 2024 held in Guwahati

- The first Bharat Steam Boiler Expo 2024was held at Veterinary College Field in Guwahati, Assam.
- The expo is organized by the Assamâ??s Inspectorate of Boilers (CIB) and supported by the Assam governmentâ??s Labour Welfare Department.
- The expo aims to improve the efficiency and growth of various sectors that use steam boilers.
- This pioneering expo is the result of a collaborative effort among industry stalwarts including Indian Oil Corporation (IOC), Oil India Ltd (OIL), Numaligarh Refinery Ltd (NRL), Brahmaputra Cracker and Polymer Ltd (BCPL), Assam Petro Chemicals Ltd, and NTPC Ltd.

#### Govt extends subsidy for Ujjwala beneficiaries by another one year

- The Union Cabinethas decided to extend the subsidy of â?<sup>1</sup>300 per LPG cylinder for up to 12 refills per year till the end of next financial year (March 2025).
- About 10.27 crore beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) will get the benefit of the scheme with its continuation set to incur â?<sup>1</sup>12,000 crore.
- The Centre had started a targeted subsidy of â?<sup>1</sup>200 per cylinder for up to 12 refills per annum to the PMUY consumers in May 2022. In October 2023, the Centre increased the subsidy to â?<sup>1</sup>300 per cylinder for up to 12 refills per year.
- As on February 1, 2024, the effective price of domestic LPG for PMUY consumers is â?<sup>1</sup>603 per LPG cylinder of 14.2 kg.
- Average LPG consumption of PMUY consumers has increased by 29% from 3.01 refills in 2019-20 to 3.87 refills (till January 2024) pro-rated for 2023-24. All PMUY beneficiaries are eligible for this targeted subsidy.

#### Worldâ??s largest literary festival-â??Sahityotsavâ?? to be held from March 11-16

- Worldâ??s largest literary festival-â??Sahityotsavâ??by Sahitya Akademi will be held from the 11th to 16th of March.
- The festival commemorating 70 years of Sahitya Akademi will witness the participation of more than a hundred renowned writers and scholars.
- Over 190 sessions and more than 175 languages of the country will also be represented during the festival.
- The Chief Guest of the Awards Presentation Ceremony will be Pratibha Rai, the distinguished Odia writer.
- The Samvatsar lecture will be delivered by renowned Urdu writer and lyricist Gulzar on the 13th of March at the Meghdoot open theatre.

#### Cabinet approves 4% hike in DA for government employees

- The Union Cabinethas approved hike in dearness allowance (DA) for central government employees and dearness relief (DR) for pensioners by 4 per cent with effect from January 1.
- With this revision, the DA will reach 50 per cent. This means various other allowances such as Housing Rent Allowances (HRA), Childrenâ??s Education and Transport Allowances, and gratuities, will also go up

based on the formula suggested by the 7th Pay Commission.

- All of them will get arrears for January and February and the revised rate for the current month, along with salary and pension for March.
- The combined impact on the exchequer, on account of both DA and DR and increase in other allowances, would be around â?<sup>1</sup>15,000 crore for January and February of FY24.
- This will benefit about 49.18 lakh central government employees and 67.95 lakh pensioners. Similar hikes are now expected for state government employees too.

#### Panama becomes 97th member of International Solar Alliance

- Panamahas officially become the 97th member of the International Solar Alliance (ISA).
- This milestone was announced by Randhir Jaiswal, the spokesperson for the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA).
- Moreover, on March 5, Malta became the 119th country to join the International Solar Alliance.
- The International Solar Alliance (ISA) is an action-oriented, member-driven, collaborative platform for increased deployment of solar energy technologies as a means for bringing energy access, ensuring energy security, and driving energy transition in its member countries.
