#### Lok Sabha

#### Rajya Sabha

Its term is 5 years and even before that, the President Rajya Sabha is a permanent house and every 2 years 1/3rd same number are newly elected.

- 2. Money Bills can be introduced only in the Lok Sabha.
- 3. The members of the Lok Sabha are elected by the people by public and secret ballot.
- 4. It cannot declare any subject in the state list as of national importance.
- Lok Sabha approves the resolution passed by Rajya Sabha.
- Lok Sabha does not need any kind of special power, because Rajya Sabha does not dissolve.

Money Bill cannot be introduced in Rajya Sabha.

The members of the Rajya Sabha are elected on the basis respective state legislatures.

The Rajya Sabha has the power to declare a matter in the importance by a resolution supported by not less than 2/31 voting in the Rajya Sabha.
